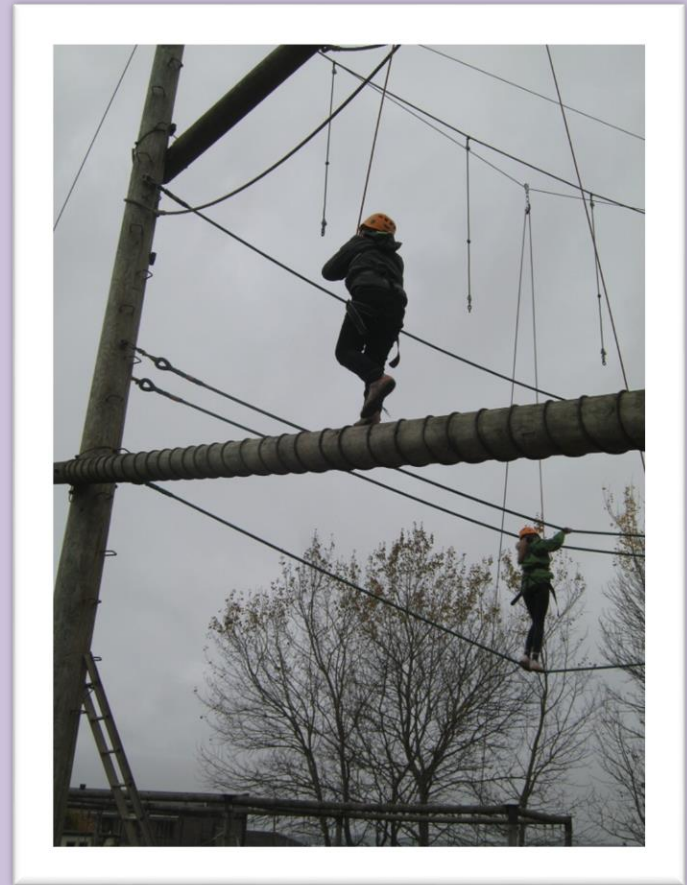

Bathroom Facilities



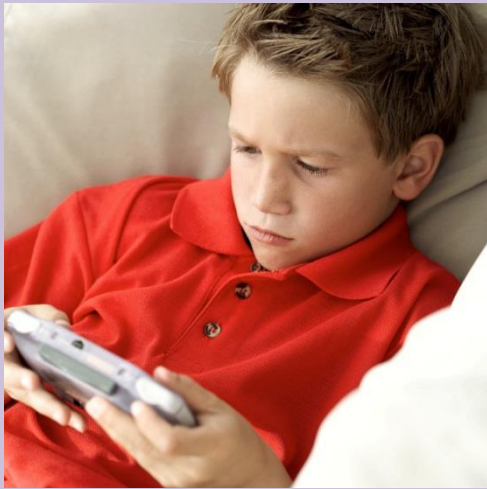
Bathrooms are next to the dorms and have multiple toilets, basins and showers.

Previous comments about the food!!

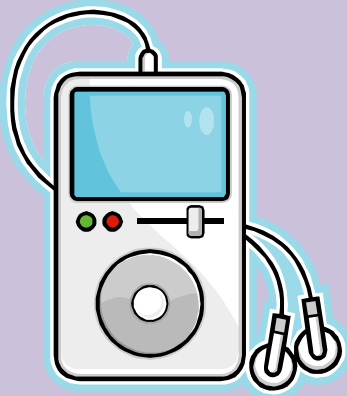
