

Guidance and Expectations for Home Learning During Lockdown January 2021

Please note that the learning will be new learning, building on previous learning and to enable the children to make progress in line with the expectations for their year group.

EYFS/Sparrow Class:

Mrs Smith is sending an email and video explaining how the home learning will work for the children in her class.

For years 1 to 6:

- The learning will be uploaded onto the school website by 4 pm the previous day. This is to allow parents to view the home learning the night before. You will be able to find these on your child's class page, under Home Learning Tab.
- The learning will be emailed to parents by 8.45 am each morning on the day of the home learning.
- As part of the daily home learning email, you will be sent a link to a short Zoom meeting led by the class teacher first thing each day. This is to allow the teacher to explain briefly the learning for the day, to encourage and support the children and to give any feedback on the learning from the previous day. Times for these Zoom meetings are as follows:

It is very important that your child joins this meeting. If you have any problems with this please ring the office. Thank you.

This is to allow the class teacher to see the work, provide feedback and adjust the planning of the learning for the following day.
