

Parents' Right to Withdraw Their Child from Collective Worship

At Teversham Church of England Primary School we wish to be an inclusive community but recognise that parents have the legal right to withdraw their children from Collective Worship on the grounds of conscience, without giving a reason.

Parents wishing to exercise this right are asked to write to the headteacher who will then invite the parents into school to discuss their concerns, clarify the nature of the Collective Worship provided by the school and set out the options open to the parents as set out in education law.

Where a pupil is withdrawn from Collective Worship, they will be supervised by an appropriate member of staff.
